Development and Fundraising Guidelines

- A. After a student's application has been approved and financial need established by the TSF Scholarship Committee, a Scholarship Confirmation Letter will be issued on behalf of the student and sent both to the student and to you as the Advocate. Funds solicitation for that student may begin after this Letter has been received.
- B. You may solicit anyone you think may be interested in assisting in funding the student's education. A natural group to solicit would be those that are close to the ministry and close to the individual – people most likely to know the effectiveness of the calling and need of the individual.
- C. You may solicit them in any way you deem necessary: letters, e-mails, telephone calls, personal visits. The only thing we ask is that you provide each prospect with a copy of the Scholarship Confirmation Letter, which provides important information regarding their contribution.
- D. You must agree to report gifts, pledges, and commitments to the TGT office as soon as possible after the gift or pledge is received.
