Recipient Spotlight

Our most recent grant recipient, One Hundred Years, is looking forward to the Southeast Youth Leader Conference in August, where they'll provide youth ministry training to over 375 paid, volunteer, and bivocational youth leaders.

One Hundred Years exists to transform the faith trajectory of each emerging generation by serving the most influential people in their lives. "We believe young people are meant to experience a faith that lasts a lifetime, but too many are walking away from the church and their faith after they leave home. We are on a mission to help churches and families build deep, Christ-centered relationships so that every young person knows they are seen and loved by God, and truly belong in the body of Christ."

One [report](#) says an estimated 40 million + young people who were raised in Christian homes could walk away from a life with Jesus by 2050. But, if the church can help them engage with Christ at rates from just two decades ago, over 20 million can know a life with Him. One Hundred Years targets both youth and youth leaders to buck this trajectory.
