#### BASIC INFO ON THE SITUATION TO SHARE WITH YOUR CONGREGATIONS

Government subsidized food is running out starting November 1, and the situation will worsen throughout the course of the month because those benefits expire on a rolling basis—so this should peak at the end of the month and go for as long as the Federal shutdown continues. The Food Bank's data says that 120,000+ people will be affected by this. Food and volunteers are going to be needed to fill the gap. Food is needed because the government is not paying for it, and volunteers are needed because local organizations were only providing a small amount of food on top of what people were getting at grocery stores.

Now that the grocery stores are no longer an option, people are going to want to get more food from food pantries, so it is expected that the system will be overloaded. Security volunteers might also be needed, depending on the size of the demand and people's level of anxiety. But all of this is a real opportunity for the churches of Chattanooga to shine!

### WAYS YOUR CONGREGATION CAN HELP

**Church Food Pantries:** We have included a list of local congregation running food pantries at the bottom of this document, so if you wanted to provide help THROUGH a local church for a Gospel witness, then these are what we know of. They will probably need more volunteer help in addition to just supplying food. *Please let us know if you are aware of additional food pantries that want to be added to the list.* 

**Social Workers:** also attached (in the email) is a list of local social workers at public schools. This is a way for your church to help people in "your neighborhood." Contact your local school's social worker and ask how you can help specific families near you.

**Supporting the Local Food Bank:** Food Banks supply food to distributors like Food Pantries (they are not the same thing). Even though it looks better to have your congregation buy food from the grocery store, it usually is better to go through the Food Bank (send a check) because they get way more food for less money. FYI: for everyone one meal the Food Bank paid for, 9 were paid for by SNAP benefits, so they are expecting a massive shortfall of over 100 million meals. Volunteers are also needed to assemble more food boxes. Links to the Food Bank:
