Confirm Charity Eligibility

If the organization is not on the list, reach out to TrustBridge Global to see if the charity is already qualified to receive grants. If they are not yet, work directly with TrustBridge on next steps.

Adding A New Charity: You will work with TBG to provide information about the charity, and the charity must submit a completed application, along with 150 CHF fee (you can pay this from your DAF, if desired). Once approved, they can receive grants from you and others in the TBG network.



Fees: The Generosity Trust does not charge additional fees. TrustBridge assesses:

- Initial Charity Fund Application Assessment of \$150 (annual renewal ___)
- Grant Assessment of 1% (minimum of \$300) when the charity draws down funds from the total amount in their account.*
- Processing assessment of \$25.

*It makes the most sense for charities to receive larger donations or pooled donations from several donors to offset the fees.

Recommend Your Grant

Recommend a grant from your donor-advised fund at The Generosity Trust to International Global Foundation (TrustBridge's US entity), referencing the charity's fund name and number.

Funds Are Distributed

When TrustBridge receives the funds, they use their network to move the funds swiftly and securely to the ministry on the ground.
